## Significant Changes to U.S. Trademark Practice: The Trademark Modernization Act of 2020

On December 18, 2021, the Trademark Modernization Act of 2020 ("TMA") went into effect, providing two new tools for individuals, businesses, and the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO") to clear away unused trademark filings based on inaccurate claims of use in U.S. commerce. The TMA further provides for discretionary shortned Office Action deadlines, expanded grounds for Letters of Protest, and clearly restores the presumption of irreparable harm to be applied to trademark infringement cases.
