# How Times Have Changed at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office

"The U.S. Patent and Trademark Office saw record numbers of new trademark applications filed in 2021. During 2021, the USPTO reported over a 25% increase in applications. See USPTO Performance and Accountability Report 2021, available at <a href="https://www.uspto.gov/sites/default/files/documents/USPTOFY21PAR.pdf">https://www.uspto.gov/sites/default/files/documents/USPTOFY21PAR.pdf</a>. Such a steep increase is thought to come from both foreign and domestic filings, with those from China outpacing growth from both U.S. applicants and applicants from other countries."

# Navigating the new Canadian Patent Rules: Managing multiple inventions while limiting costs and mitigating double patenting risks

"The new Canadian Patent Rules that came into force on October 3, 2022, introduced new fees and procedures which have the potential of substantially increasing the costs of patent prosecution in Canada. Under the new Patent Rules, excess claim fees of \$100 CAD per claim beyond the 20th must be paid at two instances during prosecution of the application: at the time of filing the Request for examination and at the time of paying the final fee."
