**Attorney James J. Kozuch Presents Intellectual Property Seminar at Tamaqua Community Art Center**

**PHILADELPHIA, PA. December 8, 2016. Philadelphia, PA.** James J. Kozuch of Caesar Rivise, PC presented an introductory seminar on Intellectual Property at the [Tamaqua Community Art Center](#) in Tamaqua, Carbon County on November 22, 2016. The presentation, entitled “An Introduction to Intellectual Property for Artists and Art Organizations,” provided an overview of patents, trademarks, trade secrets, and copyrights for artists looking to protect their work. Located about 30 miles northwest of Caesar Rivise’s [Allentown office](#), the Art Center was established in 2012 by the Tamaqua Area Community Partnership (TACP) to support the Arts in Northeastern Pennsylvania.
